A panel of professional photographers will select 60 photos to be included in a unique exhibition at Bryan Memorial Town Hall in Washington Depot, CT on Sunday, **November 17th, 2019, 2-4pm**. The exhibition will then move to The Judy Black Memorial Park and Gardens for a two-week extended viewing. The top four photographers will be recognized for their outstanding work and will receive the 2019 Dylan's Wings Photography Award and a special prize.

Share your images of family, identity, politics, community, environment, landscape, friendship, or anything else that is relevant to you.

Deadline for submissions is **October 1st**.

Grades 6-8 & 9-12:

We invite you to submit your photo in black and white or color. Any type of camera can be used.

Photography Submission Requirements:

- Submit an original, high-resolution JPEG file:
 - 3200-4000 pixels on the longest side
 - Save as .jpg
 - No larger than 25 MB
 - If you have any questions about resizing or photo specifications, please contact us, or ask your teachers or parents for help.
- Any type of camera can be used including traditional film cameras, pinhole cameras, phone cameras, etc. If you are using a Smartphone, be sure to take the photo in HDR (High Dynamic Range) to ensure the highest resolution.
- Please label your image as follows before uploading to the submission website:
 - lastname_firstname_title_grade.jpg (Example: doe_jane_myhouse_9.jpg)
- Other guidelines:
 - No diptychs or triptychs are allowed
 - You may submit up to 2 photographs
 - Photo editing is allowed this year!
